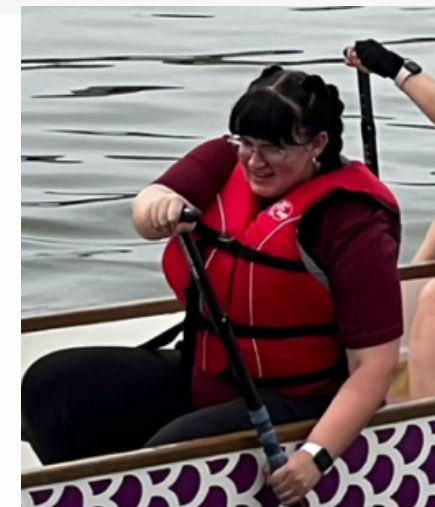

Advice for AC's specific to this session

- Be early to seating duties

WHAT IS



- abuse of any kind
- suicide
- is of a sexual nature
- self harm
- theft
- word of wisdom / drugs
- bullying. / harm to others
- leaving. campus
- skipping. scheduled activities
- breaking curfew
- opposite genders in eachothers housing
- *intentional* damages/vandalism or tampering

WHAT IS NOT



- your kids ordering Taco Bell
- weird dance moves (where the youth DID NOT touch each other)
- youth making faces at each other
- kids being lost
- honest to goodness accidental damages

When in doubt, just report it. If a red flag goes off in your brain report it :)

WHAT SHOULD BE IN A REPORT?

Summary

A summary of what happened

Quotes

Any quotes you have of what was said by the youth

Action

If any action that was taken
i.e. did you or anyone already do something

Names

Please add this in the “observed” section of the notes
